The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- 1) Candidate must be either a child or grandchild of a paid-up member in good standing.
- 2) The member must be a current member with a minimum of two full year's membership prior to the date of application.
- 3) Candidate must be a senior in High School or undergraduate in College.
- 4) Candidate must submit official transcripts from current school and a bio of extracurricular activities.
- 5) Candidate must submit essay (not to exceed 2 typed pages double spaced).
- 6) Winners of scholarship awards will not be eligible to win again the year following their award, but will be eligible the following year.

Completed applications must be postmarked and received in full by January 11, 2010. No exceptions.
